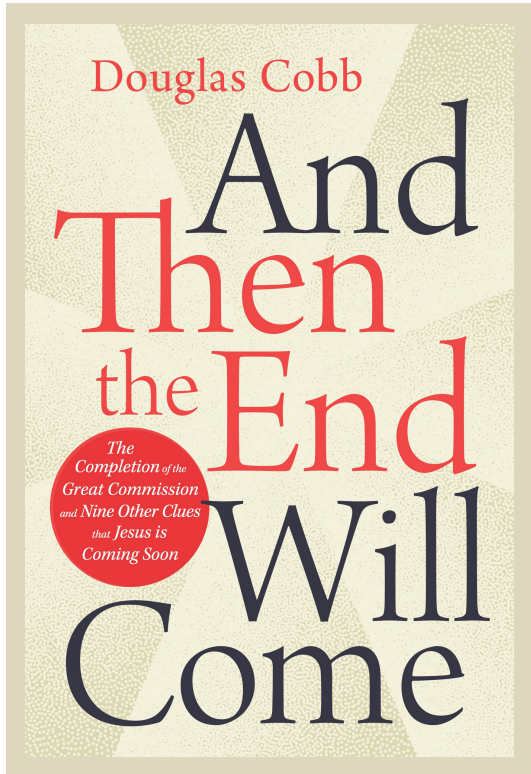

The fulfillment of The Great Commission is just around the corner—and Jesus directly linked his return to the completion of that task.

Author Douglas Cobb serves as the managing partner of the Finishing Fund, a partnership of kingdom investors who are giving together to accelerate the completion of the Great Commission. The Fund's mission is to see Jesus' command to "make disciples of every nation" fulfilled by the end of 2022.

In his debut book, ***And Then the End Will Come: The Completion of The Great Commission and Nine Other Biblical Clues that Jesus is Returning Soon***, Cobb provides a front-line account of the effort to finish Jesus' Great Commission in our lifetimes. He explains how Jesus directly linked his return to the completion of that task.

"If I'm right, Jesus is coming back in my expected lifetime—and probably yours as well," says Cobb. "That means we may have the privilege of experiencing some amazing things that believers have been looking forward to for thousands of years."

And Then the End Will Come explores nine other Biblical clues that Jesus is coming soon, including:

- the approaching 2000-year anniversary of the resurrection,
- the regathering of Israel,
- and the prophecies of Daniel 12

Cobb makes the case that the return of Christ is at hand—perhaps in the next year or two, perhaps a little later, but very likely soon. And he offers practical counsel about what it means to "live holy and godly lives" as we look for the coming of our Lord and King.

"Sadly, the church in the West is largely unaware of the remarkable events taking place around us," says Cobb. "As a result, we are discouraged by the chaos and decline we see around us, rather than seeing those things as necessary precursors to the wonderful things soon to come. Instead, we should be joyful and excited, even in the midst of the growing chaos we see around us in the world, knowing that our 'blessed hope' is close at hand."
